




5 Avenue SW Lane Closures

Notice Date: May 1, 2024

As early as May 21, CDHI will start work on 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street SW. This project will require the closure of the south lanes of 5 Avenue between 2 and 4Street SW.

What is the work? CDHI Utility Relocation – 5 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street SW

- Closure of south sidewalk and three south lanes of 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W.
- Closure of two south lanes of 5 Avenue between 3 and 4 Street S.W.

- Pedestrian detours will be in place.
- Access to loading docks and parkades maintained assisted by flaggers.

This work will be followed by a full weekend closure of 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street SW, and of 2 Street SW between 5 and 6 Avenue; and by the closure of the three middle lanes of 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street SW. Specific construction notices will be issued for each of these.

About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
